2. Upon hearing learned ASG appearing for the petitioner, we are not inclined to entertain this Special Leave Petition(s).
3. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition(s) stands dismissed. However, the observations made by

the High Court *qua* the transaction involving other accused persons, shall not affect the trial *qua* the remaining accused persons.

4. It is also observed that the findings recorded by the High Court shall not affect the trial in any manner and the trial shall be decided strictly on the basis of evidence adduced by the petitioner during the course of trial against the other accused.
